Subject: Important information from the La Crosse Job Center

Good Morning –

Instead of sending out a newsletter, I wanted to send out some important, updated information regarding the services we are providing at the La Crosse Job Center. First and foremost, know that our Job Center at 2615 East Avenue South in La Crosse is **OPEN**, with limited access/services. I have attached a flyer that is posted on our Job Center doors to give you an understanding of the new safety precautions that have been implemented here at the Job Center due to the COVID-19 outbreak. Please know that our staff are working diligently to clean and disinfect all common surfaces in between each person. (Computers, mice, chairs, pens, door handles, etc.)

Here is a breakdown of changes to our services.

- No more than 10 people will be allowed in the Job Center at one time. To enforce the social distancing rules, only six computers are available in the resource room. Other computers are available in another room to be used as needed.
- Access to the Job Center is limited to those who are applying for Unemployment Insurance benefits or searching for work.
- Use of the computers for any other reason will not be permitted (Please see the attachment for more details)
- All in-person workshops and face-to-face appointments have been canceled indefinitely.
 We will send out an updated workshop calendar when those events can again be scheduled.
- The mini Job Fair scheduled for April 16th has been canceled
